

Replacement Fee Schedule

Patrons are responsible for the condition of the library materials they borrow. If material is damaged, destroyed, lost, or stolen, the borrower should notify the library as soon as possible. The borrower may then choose one of the following options:

- Replace damaged materials with a newly purchased item (same title, author, and ISBN), deemed acceptable by the Library Director. This option is only available for materials owned by the Sunderland Public Library.
- Pay the replacement fee according to the following schedule (checks made payable to the Sunderland Public Library):
